Enclosed is the 28-day report on the bulls at Tifton. Performance has been excellent, and health has been good. The bulls gained 5.50 pounds per day this period. The weight gains for the period ranged from 87 to 239 pounds; the 28-day ADG ranged from 3.11 to 8.54 pounds; and the actual weights taken this morning ranged from 682 to 1,388 pounds.
